Students are required to construct and submit a detailed application packet that includes:

- a. Letter of Intent
- b. Resume
- c. CSI & Program Application
- d. Co-requisites & Other Points
- e. High School/GED/Prior College Transcripts
- f. CNA, EMT-B, or other patient care related "current" credential
- g. Any prior health care experience of a year or more
- h. Two letters of reference

2. Following admission into the program, students are required to show proof of:

- a. Good health with current immunizations, TB screening, and tetanus booster.
- b. Continuous health insurance coverage.
- c. Undergoing and passing a drug and background screening.
- d. CPR certification. (Health Care Provider Level)
